LOARA BAND FEST

Dear Parents and Students,

And now the fun begins. This Saturday, **October 26, 2024**, the Cavalry will be seen at the Loara Band Fest, which is a Band Review and Field Show Tournament. Let's show the kids how proud we are of them by wearing blue and navy, your Safety Orange "**SOMEWHERE**" T-shirt and cheering loudly for them at the band review and tournament. Remember, the more support we have, the better we do. Parents, I do mean **LOUDLY**, we need to hear you! *[Please no noisemakers.]*

You can get to the **band review** by taking the 60(west), 57(south) exit at Lincoln, turn west and go to Lemon, turn north. The competition zone is on Clementine Street just north of Sycamore Street and south of North Street. *(Clementine runs parallel with Harbor, to the east)* The band review starts at 10:00 AM, so leave yourself plenty of time to find a good seat.

(Our Judging time is 12:06PM) Special Note: Lincoln will be closed between 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM.

The **field tournament** takes place at Handel Stadium, at Western High School, 501 S. Western Ave., which is in the city of Anaheim. You can get to the tournament by taking the 57(south), and then taking the 91(west). After arriving in the Anaheim area, you take the Beach Blvd. exit, and head south (left) then right (west) on Orange Ave. Passenger cars will be asked to park in spectator parking off Western Ave. The evening tournament starts at 5:30PM, with Chino's performance time of **7:15 PM**, so leave yourself plenty of time to find a good seat.

****General admission for adults is \$15.00 with reduced rates for children under 12 and senior citizens. Seating for general admission spectators is on a first-come basis. Handstamps are required for re-entry to the stadium.**

Students will meet at Chino by **8:01 AM**. At this time, we will make final preparations, load the busses, and then proceed to the competition. Both competitions will be followed by an awards ceremony. After the field tournament awards are complete, we will return to Chino. **ALL MEMBERS** are required to ride the bus **TO AND FROM** the event. We should be back to Chino by **11:15 PM** Parents, please be there waiting.

ALL students will need to have eaten a healthy and hearty breakfast before arriving. For lunch, **ALL students will need to bring a sack lunch to eat at the parade site.** For dinner, we will be stopping in the Anaheim area. *(Bring between \$10.00 to \$15.00)* As always, students are allowed to bring sack dinners if they so choose. Band and Pageantry members need to make sure they bring all their performing attire, as well as their complete away uniforms. Everybody needs to make sure to have polished his or her shoes completely (sides and all) and report with hair up. **REMEMBER** there will be no time to do this for you!
